## **REGULATIONS FOR THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 RESERVED FOR EU CITIZENS AND EU EQUIVALENT CITIZENS WHO WISH TO ENROLL IN THE FIRST YEAR OF THE SINGLE-CYCLE MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAM IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY - Rome and Cefalù Campuses - AT THE SAINT CAMILLUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES (UNICAMILLUS UNIVERSITY)**

### **PREAMBLE**

UniCamillus is committed to supporting deserving and motivated students in achieving their academic and professional goals. In this spirit, the university has decided to fund scholarships for EU citizens and EU equivalent citizens enrolling in the 2026/2027 academic year. These scholarships are based on an assessment of merit, financial need, and academic performance, and are available for the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programs in Medicine and Surgery (in English) – Rome campus and Single-Cycle Master's Degree in Medicine and Surgery (in Italian) –Cefalù campus.

This regulation outlines the criteria and procedures for awarding the scholarships, which are further detailed in the specific Admission Calls.

### **Article 1 - Recipients, requirements, amounts and application procedures for the scholarship**

For the 2026/2027 academic year, scholarships funded by UniCamillus based on merit and financial need are reserved for candidates who have enrolled in the first year within the deadlines specified in the relevant Admission Call. Specifically:

#### **1.1 - Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery (in English) – Rome Campus**

Details: 50 partial scholarships, each covering 25% of the annual tuition fee.  
Requirements: placement within the top 50 positions on the ranking list and possession of an ISEE (Income Indicator for the Right to Study) not exceeding €55,000.00.  
Scholarship awarding modality: the scholarship amount will be applied to the final installment, in accordance with the "Tuition and Fees Regulation for Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programs for EU and Equivalent Students, A.Y. 2026/2027 – Rome Campus."

#### **1.2 - Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery (in Italian) – Cefalù Campus**

- a) Details: 1 partial scholarship, covering 50% of the annual tuition fee.  
Requirements: applicants must be born and residing in the Sicily Region, have been admitted to the degree program after selecting the Cefalù campus as their first choice during the admission test registration process, and meet curriculum merit and ISEE income assessment criteria. In this regard, the following criteria will be evaluated in this order: high school diploma final grade, average grade of the last year of secondary school, ISEE of the family unit. In the event of a tie in diploma grades and academic average, priority will be given to the student with the lower ISEE.  
Scholarship awarding modality: The scholarship amount will be applied to the last two installments, in accordance with the "Tuition and Fees Regulation for Single-Cycle Master's

Degree Programs for EU and Equivalent Students, A.Y. 2026/2027 – Cefalù Campus."

- b) Details: Partial scholarships covering 30% of the annual tuition fee, reserved for a maximum of 30% of the available spots in the degree program. Requirements: applicants must be born and resident in the Region of Sicily and must have been admitted to the degree program by ranking among the top 60 candidates, having selected the Cefalù campus as their first choice during the admission test registration process.

Scholarship Awarding Modality: The scholarship amount will be applied to the final two instalments, in accordance with the " Tuition and Fees Regulation for Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programs for EU and Equivalent Students, A.Y. 2026/2027 – Cefalù Campus."

The scholarships cannot be combined.

For all scholarships outlined in points 1.1 and 1.2 of this article, the application procedures and deadlines, as well as the scholarship awarding process by the University, are detailed in the corresponding Admission Call.

## **Article 2 - Requirements for Maintaining the Partial Scholarship**

### **2.1 - Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery in English – Rome Campus / Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery in Italian – Lido di Venezia Campus**

Students awarded the scholarships described in points 1.1 and 1.2 of Article 1) of this Regulation may retain the same benefit for the subsequent years, up to the legal duration of the program, provided that by September 30 of each academic year, they meet the following requirements:

- 1) Acquisition of a number of ECTS (CFU) credits at least equal to those listed in the following table:

<b>Year</b>	<b>ECTS (CFU)</b>
2nd	40
3rd	98
4th	157
5th	215
6th	280

- 2) An arithmetic mean of at least 27/30 achieved in the exams corresponding to the total ECTS credits earned.

To maintain the scholarship in subsequent years, all the above-mentioned requirements must be met. The scholarship application will result in an adjustment of the final installment, the deadline for which is specified in the relevant Tuition and Fees Regulations for the 2026/2027 academic year.

### **2.2 - Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery in English – Cefalù Campus**

Students awarded the scholarships mentioned in point 1.2 of Article 1) of this Regulation may retain the same benefit in subsequent years, up to the legal duration of the program, provided that by September 30 of each academic year, they meet the following requirements:

- 1) completion of all exams outlined in the study plan for the relevant academic year;
- 2) a grade average of 26/30;
- 3) possession of a valid ISEE for university student financial aid, with an amount not exceeding €55,000.00.

To retain the scholarship in subsequent years, all the requirements outlined in this article must be met.

The scholarship will be applied by adjusting the penultimate and/or final installment, with the due date specified in the relevant Tuition and Fees Regulations for the 2026/2027 academic year.

The Registrar's Office will be in charge of verifying whether the requirements for maintaining the scholarships outlined in this article are met and will inform the concerned students of the results.

### **Article 3 – Forfeiture**

A student will lose eligibility for the scholarship if they fail to meet one or more of the maintenance requirements specified in Article 2).

### **Article 4 - Privacy**

In accordance with Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, UniCamillus University, located at Via di Sant'Alessandro n. 8, 00131 Rome, as the Data Controller, hereby informs that the personal data provided by the individuals as required will be processed exclusively for the purposes of carrying out the procedures outlined in this Regulation. ### **Article 5 – Warnings**

The scholarships provided for in these Regulations may not be combined with other scholarships awarded by UniCamillus for the Academic Year 2026/2027 and described in the relevant Regulations.

For legal and interpretative purposes, the version of this Regulation approved and deposited with the Competitions, Decrees, and Regulations Office, drafted in Italian, shall prevail. A certified copy is available upon request.

Any matters not explicitly covered in this document shall be governed by the University's Statute and the Regulations that oversee its operations.
