## REGULATION FOR THE AWARDING OF PARTIAL OR FULL SCHOLARSHIPS/HONOUR LOANS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 FOR NON-EU CANDIDATES LIVING ABROAD AND WISHING TO REGISTER IN THE FIRST YEAR OF THE DEGREE PROGRAMMES OF THE SAINT CAMILLUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES (UNICAMILLUS UNIVERSITY).

### INTRODUCTION

In the belief that deserving and motivated students should be supported in pursuing their academic and professional aspirations, UniCamillus has decided to fund scholarships/honour loans based on the assessment of students' financial circumstances, merit, and academic progress. These are intended for young people residing in non-EU countries with limited economic resources, with the aim of training healthcare professionals who will then return to their home countries to carry out their professional mission.

### Article 1. Student loans recipients

For the academic year 2026/2027, scholarships/honour loans provided by UniCamillus and based on merit and income, are for non-EU citizens living abroad who registered for one of the following degree programmes:

#### MSc Programmes

- Medicine and Surgery (in English);
- Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics (in Italian).

#### Bsc Programmes in the Health Professions

- Midwifery (in Italian);
- Nursing (in English)
- Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques (in English).

The application for benefits follows a procedure that is separate from the enrollment process. A student who has submitted an application and has been deemed eligible for the award of a scholarship will lose their eligibility status if they do not proceed with enrollment.

### Article 2. Value of partial and full scholarships/honour loans

For the academic year 2026/2027, UniCamillus offers:

- A maximum of 10 partial scholarships or full scholarships/honour loans covering the full annual tuition fee payable by the student for the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics;
- a maximum of 30 scholarships providing partial coverage, or scholarships/honour Loans providing full coverage of the annual tuition fee due for the six-year Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery.

- A maximum of 10 scholarships providing partial coverage, or scholarships/honour loans providing full coverage of the annual tuition fee owed by the student for each degree programme in the Health Professions.

The University reserves the right to increase the number of scholarships/honour loans announced in the call, including at a later stage, should the Evaluation Committee deem it necessary to expand the number of scholarships/honour loans to be awarded to particularly deserving candidates.

For the academic year 2026/2027, the full scholarship/honour loan covers the annual tuition fee owed by the student.

For the academic year 2026/2027, the amount of the partial scholarship shall range from a minimum of 25% to a maximum of 50% of the annual tuition fee established for the degree programme (single-cycle master's degree or bachelor's degree), as provided for in the "Tuition Fees and Contributions Regulations A.Y. 2026/2027 – Rome Campus";

Please note that partial and full scholarships/honour loans do not cover regional tax, which has not yet been set for the academic year 2026/2027 (for the academic year 2025/2026, it was € 140.00). The benefit provided by the partial scholarship and the full scholarship/honour loan may be renewed annually until graduation, provided that the student continues to meet the requirements set out in Article 6 of these regulations.

### **Article 3. Features of the full scholarship/honour loans**

The scheme used for the full scholarship is the "honour loan," which is fully cleared if, after graduation, the professional returns to practice in their home country or a similar country, identified in agreement with the University, for a period of at least three years.

### **Article 4. Committee for the Award of Partial Scholarships and Full Scholarships/Honour Loans**

To ensure fairness and transparency in the procedures for awarding scholarships/honour loans, UniCamillus will appoint a Committee with humanitarian awareness and experience in education and training.

### **Article 5. Procedure and conditions for submitting applications for the award of partial and full scholarships/honour loans**

Applications for the award of scholarships/honours student loans must be submitted exclusively online (as shown in the guide in Annex 1) through the student portal within the deadline established in the relevant calls for applications published on the official website.

After entering all the required data, candidates must upload the following documentation:

**MANDATORY**

- Application for partial or full scholarship/honour loan (Annex A, downloadable from the portal);
- Motivation letter;
- Student's CV;
- High school diploma; or, if a diploma is not available, the student's most recent report card;
- Documentation certifying the student's family economic and financial situation, translated into English and presented in a clear format;
- Declaration of acknowledgment of the report on the processing of personal data pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679 on the "Protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" (hereinafter also "GDPR"), (Annex B, downloadable from the portal).

In total or partial absence of the above documentation, the application will not be considered valid and will not be vetted by the Commission.

#### OPTIONAL

- Any document, publication, work material, research, relevant activities carried out by the applicant and consistent with the course of study the candidate wants to undertake and/or to Unicamillus' values and mission;
- One or more letters of recommendation written by teachers or by individuals who have contributed to the candidate's educational and academic development;
- Documentation indicating the composition of the applicant's family.

All documentation must be uploaded on to the student portal Gomp <https://unicamillus-studenti.gomp.it/> in the appropriate sections.

Please note: the files uploaded on to the platform must not exceed 30 MB.

An interview may be requested by the Evaluation Committee.

Applicants cannot benefit from other scholarships/honour loans provided by other public or private bodies in the same academic year.

The awarding of scholarships will be granted until the financial resources allocated by the University are exhausted.

#### **Article 6. Requirements for partial and/or full scholarships/honour loan renewal**

For students awarded a partial scholarship and/or a full scholarship/honour loan for the 2026/2027 academic year, it may be renewed annually for a number of years equal to the official duration of the programme, provided they meet the following requirements:

- an average score in the exams of the previous academic year equal to or higher than 26/30.
- Maintenance or deterioration of the economic and financial situation of the student's family unit as declared at the time of the first award.

- Acquisition of a minimum annual number of University Educational Credits (ECTS/CFU) as specified in the tables below:

- Students awarded a partial or a FULL scholarship/honour loan must obtain the required ECTS credits by the September exam session corresponding to the current year of enrollment;
- If the ECTS credits specified in Table 1 are not obtained or the average mark of the exams is lower than 26/30, the student will lose the benefit and will have to pay the required tuition fees, in accordance with the “Tuition Fees Regulation for the academic year 2026/2027 EU and NON-EU students – Rome Campus” of reference;
- Students awarded a partial scholarship or a full scholarship/honour loan are required to obtain their degree within the official duration of the corresponding degree programme. However, for the purpose of maintaining the benefit, an additional period of 6 months may be granted for completing the degree; after this additional 6-month period, the partial scholarship or full scholarship/honour loan will be withdrawn, and the awarded student will be required to pay the contributions as established in the relevant “Tuition and Fees Regulations for the 2026/2027 Academic Year.

The fulfillment of the aforementioned requirements constitutes a necessary condition for renewal, but not a sufficient one, as the latter remains entirely at the discretion of the University. The University will also assess additional factors, such as, by way of example and not limitation, the student’s overall conduct within the Academic Community, the behavior exhibited in the broader

context of Italian civil society in which they will live, as well as the availability of resources allocated for Scholarships.

#### **Article 7. Loss of partial and/or full scholarship/honour loan**

The student shall forfeit the right to the partial and/or full scholarship/honour loan if he or she:

- submits a formal withdrawal from studies or transfers to another university;
- incurs disciplinary sanctions more severe than a written warning for offences committed during his or her academic career at UniCamillus;
- engages in conduct that does not comply with the general rules of behavior, both within the University and in the healthcare facilities where he or she carries out internship activities;
- fails to submit to UniCamillus any original documentation required to verify the truthfulness of the self-certifications provided;
- in the case of a partial scholarship, is not in good standing with the payment of the remaining required tuition fees and contributions;
- submits or declares data that is subsequently found to be untrue.

#### **Article 8. Processing of personal data**

Pursuant to Article of EU Regulation 2016/679 UniCamillus University (located in Via di Sant'Alessandro n. 8, 00131 Rome), acting as Data Controller in this matter, declares that the required personal data provided by the interested parties will be processed exclusively for the fulfillment of the procedures described in this Notice.
