The European Student Card (ESC) is the personal digital card issued by UniCamillus that allows secure and reliable identification of European students.

This tool was created to facilitate access to services on and off campus (such as libraries, canteens, transport, and access to university facilities), both at your home institution and while abroad.

The European Student Card initiative is fundamental to promoting participation in educational and cultural activities.

It represents a decisive step towards digital transition and towards a genuine European Education Area, in which studying abroad will become the norm and educational excellence will be accessible to all.

Services, Benefits and International Mobility

Currently, over 500 institutions in 36 countries have already joined the initiative.

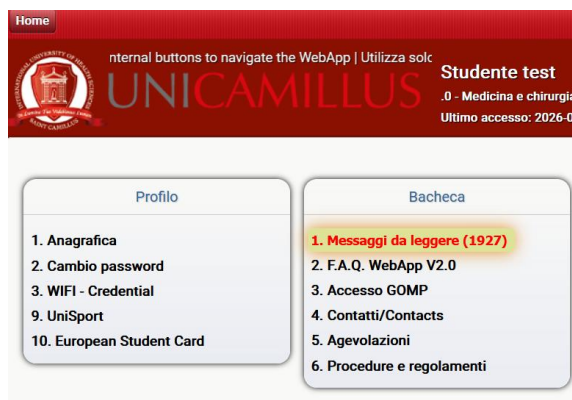
If you are taking part in an international mobility programme (such as Erasmus), the ESC will offer you significant benefits:

- **Simplified bureaucracy:** it facilitates accreditation procedures with partner institutions and simplifies the administrative management of student life abroad.
- **Official recognition:** it can serve as an official identification document for students during academic exchanges.
- **Access to European services:** depending on how the individual host institution is organised, the card will allow you to access libraries, sports centres, university canteens, cultural events, and dedicated discounts.

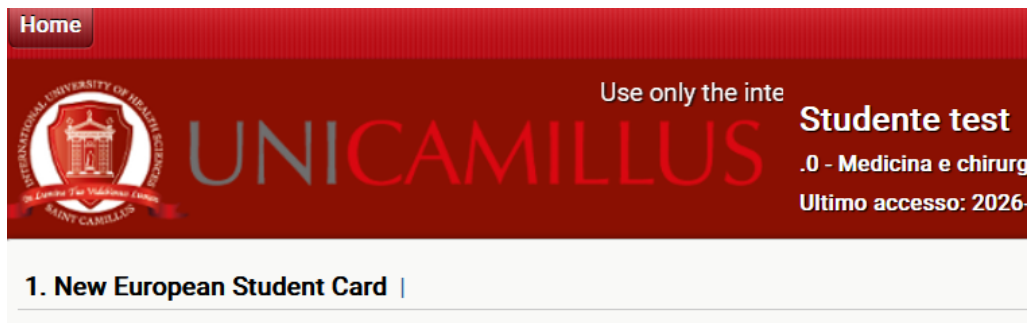
Once fully implemented within the ESC system, the card will make European mobility an integrated and barrier-free experience. For more details about the initiative, you can consult the official European Commission page.

How to request it

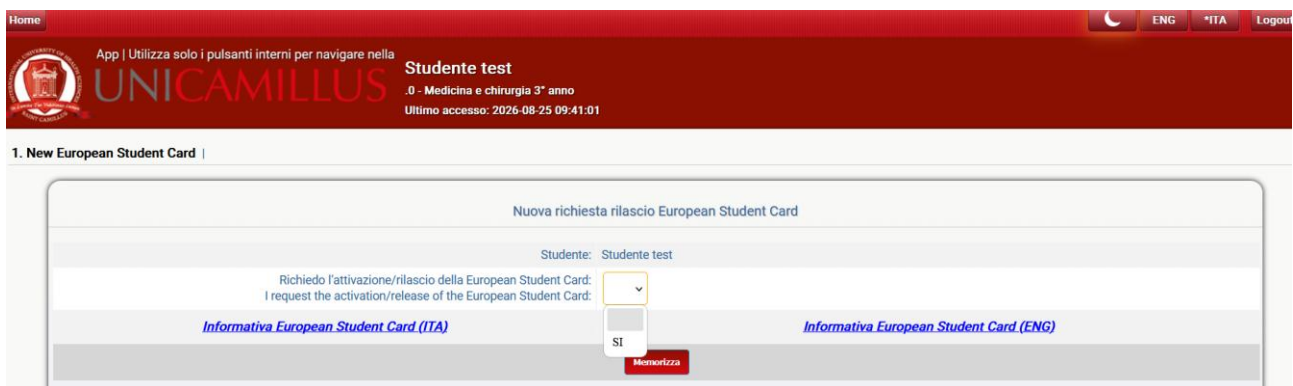
After logging into the [UniCamillus WebApp](#) with your personal credentials, you will need to click on **10. European Student Card**



You will then need to click on **1. New European Student Card**



Please read the privacy notice and then click YES /SI and Save/Memorizza.



At this point your request will be complete, and within 48 hours, by returning to the **10. European Student Card** section, your digital card will be ready!
