

Learning Agreement (LA)

The Learning Agreement (LA) must be submitted within:

15th of August for the Winter semester and whole academic year.

15th of December for the Summer semester.

We are on EWP, please use the OLA platform.

Once the LA is accepted, the student will receive the credential for the WebApp, the University platform.

Acceptance/Admission

The enrollment process requires:

- **Submission of the health documentation** (Tuberculin test done in the last 12 months and performed through the Mantoux technique or with the Quantiferon test. According to the provisions of the Competent Physician of UniCamillus, the tuberculin test has a validity of one year). The certificate of vaccination against viral hepatitis B. Vaccination Booklet; Uploading of Medical documents on our WebApp;
- **Request of The Student Badge** (done through the Web app) – This Is Necessary To Register Attendance!



Mandatory Medical Documents for the Internship

- Routine blood tests (Glycaemia, Azotemia, Transaminases, Gamma-glutamyl Transferase (GGT) Complete blood count);
- HBV Test (HBs-Ag; HbsAb);
- HCV Test (Anti-HCV);
- Measles IgG (IgG Measles test);
- TBC Test (Mantoux or Quantiferon Test);
- Vaccination booklet: Hepatitis B, Measles, Rubella, Mumps with two doses of MPR, certificate of varicella infection.

We offer the following programmes:

- Medicine – English – 6-year programme – 360 ECTS
- Dental Medicine – Italian – 6-year programme – 360 ECTS
- Nutrition and Dietetics – Italian – 2-year programme – 120 ECTS
- Nursing – English – 3-year programme – 180 ECTS
- Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques – English – 3-year programme – 180 ECTS
- Biomedical Laboratory Technique – Italian – 3-year programme – 180 ECTS
- Midwifery – Italian – 3-year programme – 180 ECTS

Incoming students may choose subjects from different study years, provided that this does not result in timetable overlaps.

Teaching Language

Courses in English



- **Medicine and Surgery;**
- **Physiotherapy;**
- **Nursing;**
- **Imaging Radiotherapy Technique.**

The main teaching language is English. The recommended English level to follow these courses is B1.

Courses in Italian



- **Midwifery;**
- **Dentistry;**
- **Biomedical Laboratory Technique.**

The main teaching language is Italian. The recommended Italian level to follow these courses is B1, better B2.

Language Requirements for Internship

Italian: B1/ better B2 - it needs to be officially certified with a certificate **legally recognized in Europe** in order to gain access to public hospitals for the internship.

Practical Information

Study Visa

Non-EU nationals have to apply for a **study visa at the nearest Italian Embassy or Consulate** before entering Italy. Invitation Letters and Letters of Acceptance for the visa application are issued upon receipt of the scan of the signed application documents. Non-EU Erasmus students who have a **study visa** or a **residence permit for studies** for another EU-country which is valid until the end of the planned exchange period, have to contact: relations@unicamillus.org.

Health Insurance Requirements

Exchange students must have valid health insurance equivalent to Italian statutory coverage, including all treatments (dental, psychological, pregnancy) for the full stay.

- **EU Nationals:** European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is accepted. Apply early, especially for UK and French students.
- **Non-EU Nationals:** Must purchase Italian statutory health insurance (e.g., Allianz).

Additional travel insurance is recommended for the period between departure and semester start. Private foreign insurances with limited coverage or duration are not accepted for enrollment.
