### PREREQUISITES

In order to take the final exam, which has the value of a State exam qualifying the practice of the profession, it is necessary to have acquired 174 University Education Credits (CFU) deriving from passing all the training activities foreseen in the study plan of the BSc in Physiotherapy, including those relating to internship activities and seminar activities.

### LEARNING OBJECTIVES

At the end of the Course the student must possess the specific knowledge, skills and competences required by the professional profile of the Physiotherapist, necessary to take the qualifying practical test.

Furthermore, the student must be able to use scientific research methods to draft the final thesis.

### LEARNING OUTCOMES

#### Knowledge and Understanding

The student must possess the theoretical-practical and technical-operational knowledge and skills required by the professional profile of the Physiotherapist, in addition to knowledge of scientific research methods.

#### Applying knowledge and understanding

The student will be able to apply the skills required by the professional profile of the Physiotherapist, in accordance with the best scientific evidence and in compliance with ethical-deontological standards. He will also be able to adopt research methods in the rehabilitation field for the drafting of the final thesis.

#### Communication skills

The student must demonstrate the ability to use adequate scientific terminology, both to communicate appropriately in various clinical contexts and with different interlocutors (health professionals, patients, caregivers, etc.), and in the final dissertation.

#### Making judgements

The student will be able to use the knowledge acquired in the three-year training period in

an appropriate manner for different healthcare contexts, critically interpreting the data collected for the final dissertation.

### **Learning skills**

The student will have acquired skills and learning methods suitable for deepening and improving their skills in the field of rehabilitation sciences, also through consultation of scientific literature.

## **COURSE GRADE DETERMINATION**

The final exam, having the value of a state exam qualifying the practice of the profession, involves the taking of a practical exam and the dissertation of the Thesis.

During the practical exam the student will have to demonstrate that he has acquired the specific theoretical-practical skills of his professional profile, through the evaluation and treatment of a clinical case presented in a real context (outpatient or ward) in one of the healthcare facilities in agreement with the University, in the presence of the Graduation Commission.

Passing the practical exam will allow the candidate to be admitted to the discussion of the thesis.

The Graduation Commission assigns a score between 0 and 12 points to the final exam, divided as follows:

- From 0 to 5 points for the evaluation of the practical exam (the exam is considered passed by obtaining a score equal to or greater than 1);
- From 0 to 5 points for the evaluation of the thesis;
- 1 additional point for students graduating in progress;
- 1 additional point for those who joined the Erasmus program during their studies.

Furthermore, students who have carried out student representation activities in University are awarded an additional point.

## **SUPPORT ACTIVITIES**

The Teaching Management plans optional laboratory activities for in-depth analysis and support for passing the final exam, provided by the Professors of the Course of Studies and/or by the Clinical internship Tutors.
