Overview:

UMIS is an international advanced training program in implant surgery designed for clinicians seeking comprehensive education in modern surgical and prosthetic implant rehabilitation through a flexible blended-learning model.

Partner:

The CPD course main partner is Istituto Stomatologico Toscano (IST), chaired by Prof. Ugo Covani.

Location:

Theoretical and practical activities will be delivered in blended learning mode through:

- Online live webinars,
- In-person educational sessions in Istanbul, Türkiye,
- Academic coordination activities at "Unicamillus International Medical University", Rome, Italy, and "Istituto Stomatologico Toscano" (IST), Camaiore, Italy.

Duration:

The CPD course lasts 12 months and includes a total time of 1.500 hours, divided into webinars, lectures, seminars, practical activities, clinical discussions, individual study, and final examination.

The teaching staff is further enriched by additional national and international faculty members who contribute their expertise and experience to the CPD course.

Attendance Mode:

The attendance is mandatory for at least 80% of the total hours of the Master Program. The Master Program is composed of:

- 3 online educational sessions
- 2 in-person educational sessions in Istanbul, each lasting 3 days

The final in-person session will include the final examination and thesis discussion.

Admission and selection criteria:

To be eligible for admission to the Master's program, candidates must hold at least one of the following degrees:

- MSc in Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics (Laurea Magistrale in Odontoiatria e Protesi Dentaria) or an equivalent qualification – Degree Class LM-46; EQF Level 7
- MSc in Medicine and Surgery (Laurea Magistrale in Medicina e Chirurgia) or an equivalent qualification – Degree Class LM-41; EQF Level 7
