GIVEN the University's CPD first- and second-level course Regulations approved by the Organising Technical Committee on 30th March 2023;
GIVEN the University's Code of Ethics and Organization, Management and Control Model no. 231;
GIVEN law no. 168 of 19th May 1989, concerning the establishment of the Ministry of University and Research (MUR);

HEREBY DECREES

Article no.1

Title	Implant Surgery (UMIS)

Objectives	UMIS is an international advanced training program in implant surgery designed for clinicians seeking comprehensive education in modern surgical and prosthetic implant rehabilitation through a flexible blended-learning model.
No. of places available	A minimum number of 12 enrolment is requested in order to activate the Master Program. Below the threshold of 12 enrolments, UniCamillus can unilaterally decide not to activate the Master Program (with return of any already paid participant fees). The maximum number of students is 30.
Course structure and methodology	<p>The attendance is mandatory for at least 80% of the total hours of the Master Program. The Master Program is composed of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 3 online educational sessions ● 2 in-person educational sessions in Istanbul, each lasting 3 days <p>The final in-person session will include the final examination and thesis discussion.</p>

<p>Eligible students and admission requirements</p>	<p>To be eligible for admission to the Master’s program, candidates must hold at least one of the following degrees:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Master’s Degree in Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics (<i>Laurea Magistrale in Odontoiatria e Protesi Dentaria</i>) or an equivalent qualification – Degree Class LM-46; EQF Level 7 ● Master’s Degree in Medicine and Surgery (<i>Laurea Magistrale in Medicina e Chirurgia</i>) or an equivalent qualification – Degree Class LM-41; EQF Level 7 <p>Candidates with a degree completed abroad comparable in duration and content to an Italian degree required for admission to a CPD course may also apply. If this is the case, candidates must provide a declaration of value issued by the Italian consular authority in the country of study (accompanied by a transcript of records and a copy of the final diploma), or a Certificate of Comparability, CIMEA/ Statement of Correspondence (ARDI) issued by CIMEA (accessing the CIMEA platform) with an accompanying Verification Certificate, or a Diploma Supplement (for European degree titles) issued by the university of origin and legalized at the Italian Embassy in the country of study. Candidates who do not possess or do not present an eligible degree certificate at the time of enrolment, in accordance with current regulations, forfeit their enrolment, if already admitted, and are not entitled to any refund.</p>
<p>Enrolment methods</p>	<p>Candidates who meet the requirements indicated must proceed with enrolment directly through the GOMP portal, following information provided in the enrolment guide on the UniCamillus website.</p> <p>To finalize the application, the following documentation must be provided and uploaded on to the portal during enrolment:</p>

	<p>A) certification of the degree title or authenticated copy of the degree title, or, provisionally, self-certification. Candidates holding a degree completed abroad must present, under penalty of exclusion, the original official translation into Italian of the academic qualifications, complete with legalization and Declaration of Value issued by the Italian Embassy or Italian Consulate competent for the territory in the country where the degree was completed;</p> <p>B) photocopy of a valid identification document;</p> <p>C) photocopy of the health insurance card;</p> <p>D) digital passport photo (JPEG or PNG format);</p> <p>E) privacy information in accordance with EU Regulation no.2016/679 on "the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" available on the GOMP portal, to be uploaded during enrolment;</p> <p>F) student contract available on the GOMP portal, to be uploaded during enrolment.</p> <p>For candidates holding equivalent qualifications:</p> <p>G) Declaration of Value issued by the Italian consular authority in the country of study (accompanied by a transcript of records + copy of the final diploma) or a CIMEA Comparability Statement accompanied by a CIMEA Verification Statement (accessing the CIMEA platform) or a Diploma Supplement (for European degree titles) issued by the University of origin and legalized at the Italian Embassy in the country of study.</p> <p>Applicants who submit incomplete documentation are still admitted but cannot finalize enrolment until all the required documentation is presented.</p> <p>Please note that enrolment will be considered completed only after payment of the first instalment and secretarial fees.</p>
<p>Enrolment fees</p>	<p>The total tuition fee is € 9.050,00, plus € 50,00 for secretarial fees (including registration and degree certificate stamp duty). The fee is payable in three instalments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1st instalment: € 3.050,00 + € 50,00 - Registration and first payment must be completed by the deadline indicated on the website. ● 2nd instalment: € 3.000,00 by the date indicated on the website ● 3rd instalment: € 3.000,00 by the date indicated on the website <p>Enrolment will be considered completed only after payment.</p> <p>Discontinued attendance of the lectures does not in any way relieve the student from the obligation to pay the remaining fees.</p> <p>RIGHT OF WITHDRAWAL - If enrolment has been completed remotely or outside of the University itself, students may exercise the right of withdrawal within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of enrolment (the payment date will be taken as reference), and, as a result, unilaterally withdraw by clearly communicating to UniCamillus their wish to withdraw. This request must be sent by CEM to the address postlaurea.unicamillus@pec.it. UniCamillus will proceed to reimburse the amount paid within the following 14 (fourteen) days, retaining an amount equal to 5% of the amount paid for secretarial services and using the same payment method used by the student, unless indicated otherwise.</p> <p>Outside of the cases expressly provided for in this call for applications, no refund will be made under any circumstances.</p> <p>RIGHT TO LEAVE THE COURSE - By exercising the right to leave the course, students will no longer be allowed access to lectures or tools made available to them by UniCamillus.</p> <p>Students who wish to leave the course must submit a request through an online procedure by accessing the student portal (Gomp) with their credentials, by going to the "career>questions>request to leave the course" section.</p> <p>In case of withdrawal, no amount already paid up to the time of submitting the request will be refunded under any circumstances.</p>

	Students wishing to leave the course after the start of lectures are still required to pay the full amount of fees, as prescribed.
Provisions	<p>Participation in this call for admissions implies full and unquestionable acceptance of the provisions contained therein, including the provisions contained in the "Student Contract" attached to this call, which is an integral part thereof.</p> <p>For legal and interpretation purposes, the text of this call written in Italian, approved by a specific Rector's Decree, available from the Teaching Services Office, of which a certified copy can be obtained, shall prevail. For all information not contained in this document, reference is made to the Statute and Regulations that govern the functioning and activities of the University.</p>
