HEREBY DECREES

Eligible students and admission requirements

In order to be adimtted to the course candidates must have a high school diploma and an MSc in Medicine and Surgery.

Candidates with a degree completed abroad comparable in duration and content to an Italian degree required for admission to a CPD course may also apply. If this is the case, candidates must provide a declaration of value issued by the Italian consular authority in the country of study (accompanied by a transcript of records and a copy of the final diploma), or a Certificate of Comparability issued by CIMEA (accessing the CIMEA platform) with an accompanying Verification Certificate, or a Diploma Supplement (for European degree titles) issued by the university of origin and legalized at the Italian Embassy in the country of study. Candidates who do not possess or do not present an eligible degree certificate within 3 months of enrolment, in accordance with current regulations, forfeit their enrolment, if already admitted, and are not entitled to any refund.

If the prescribed requirements are not met, the Teaching Services Office may, at any time and with a reasoned decision, exclude the candidate from the programme.

In compliance with law no. 33 of 12th April 2022, and in accordance with the note from the Ministry of University and Research (MUR) no. 16767 of 6th July 2022, each student is allowed to simultaneously enrol in two degree programmes, master's programmes, or CPD courses at multiple universities, schools, or higher education institutions, including foreign ones. However, concurrent enrolment in two degree programmes of the same class or in the same CPD course, even in different institutions, is not allowed.

	To finalize the application, the following documentation must be provided and uploaded on to the portal during enrolment:
	European-style CV, dated and signed.
	Copy of a valid identity document.
	Copy of the Degree Certificate.
	• Declaration of having read the Information Notice regarding the processing of personal data, in accordance with Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulations 2016/679 on the "protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" (hereinafter also referred to as "GDPR") provided by UniCamillus.
	• Copy of the tax identification number or health insurance card (for Italian citizens and foreigners in possession of one).
	For candidates holding equivalent qualifications to those required, a self-declaration in lieu of a certification is required, in accordance with Article 46 point m of Legislative Decree no. 445 of 28 th December 2000 certifying the attainment of said qualifications, in accordance with current legislation.
	Applications with incomplete documentation or incorrect transcription of data on the application form will not be accepted.
	After admission, candidates must follow the enrolment procedure as indicated in the appropriate guide, which will be sent via email along with a notification of admission to the course.
Provisions	Participation in the admission process implies full and unquestionable acceptance of the provisions contained therein.
	The University reserves the right, for organizational reasons, to postpone or suspend the course if the minimum number of students required by this announcement is not reached. If the number of students exceeds the minimum, the University may postpone or suspend the course until further notice.
	For legal and interpretation purposes, the text of this call written in Italian, approved by a specific Rector's Decree, available from the Teaching Services Office, of which a certified copy can be obtained, shall prevail. For all information not contained in this document, reference is made to the Statute and Regulations that govern the functioning and activities of the University.
