RECTOR'S DECREE No. 82 of 13th February 2026

THE RECTOR

Given the Statute of the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus University);

Given the Academic Regulations of Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus University);

Given Law No. 264 of 1999, "Regulations governing admission to university courses."

Given Ministerial Decree No. 270/2004, "Amendments to the Regulation containing rules concerning the didactic autonomy of Universities."

Given the "Tuition and Fees Regulation for the A.Y. 2025/2026" approved by the Board of Directors of UniCamillus University on 18th December 2024;

DECREES

For the purposes of professional development, curricular integration, and cultural enrichment, UniCamillus allows enrollment in the single courses listed in the table referred to in Article 2, pertaining to 2nd semesters of the first-year and second-year study plan of the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery taught in English, at the Rome campus.

1) Requirements

Enrollment in the single courses detailed below, as well as the completion of the related exams with subsequent formal certification, is allowed exclusively for EU and EU-equivalent candidates who meet one of the following conditions:

1. hold a five-year upper secondary school diploma;
2. hold a university degree awarded by UniCamillus or by another Italian or international university;
3. are currently enrolled at another Italian university.

Students holding a foreign upper secondary school qualification must submit the diploma with a sworn translation into Italian or English, accompanied by the Verification and/or Comparability Statements issued by CIMEA. Students coming from non-Italian universities must also submit a declaration issued by the Italian Embassy or the Italian Consulate General competent for their territory, certifying that the university is officially recognised by the relevant government.

All documentation required under this article must be submitted within the deadline established for enrolment in the single course, as indicated in Article 3.

2) Description of Single Courses

The single courses covered by this notice refer to the 2nd semesters of the first-year and second-year study plan of the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery taught in English at the Rome campus. Enrollment in single courses is allowed up to a maximum of 36 ECTS credits. The courses are detailed as follows:

3) Procedures and Deadlines for Submitting Applications

Applications to participate in the call must be submitted exclusively by completing the dedicated form available on the University's official website and sending it **only via certified email (PEC)** to office.unicamillus@pec.it, attaching a valid identity document.

Applications for single course enrollment will be accepted in chronological order of submission via certified email (PEC) until available seats are exhausted, and must be received **by 1:00 PM on February 27th, 2026**.

Following confirmation from the Student Office, candidates may proceed with online enrollment through the Gomp student portal by following the provided instructions. Single course enrolment must be finalized online via the Gomp student portal within 48 hours of receiving the communication from the Student Office, sent through the same channel used by candidates when submitting their application. Failure to finalize the enrollment within the specified timeframe will result in the candidate being considered to have withdrawn.

Applications missing the required documentation and/or submitted through channels other than those specified in this notice will not be evaluated and will be considered null and void.

4) Attendance of Lectures and Exams

Lectures will be delivered in class starting from 2nd March 2026, at the UniCamillus campus in Rome. The detailed schedule of lectures and exams can be consulted on the University's website at the following link: <https://unicamillus.org/en/courses/msc/medicine-and-surgery-rome/#calendar>

Students enrolled in single courses will take exams following the same procedures and timelines as students enrolled in the degree programme. Exams must be completed no later than September 30th, 2026. Should a student enrolled in single courses later decide to enrol in a Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme at UniCamillus, they may request recognition of credits earned through passed exams.

To be eligible to take exams, students must be up to date with the required fees and must have attended at least 67% of the lectures scheduled in the relevant academic calendar.

5) Fee Overview

The fees for enrollment in single courses include:

- A revenue stamp (marca da bollo) worth €16.00;
- A fee of €350.00 per ECTS credit (CFU).

Payments must be made exclusively through the methods provided by the University via the Gomp student portal (PagoPA or CBILL payment slip).

The fee is divided into two installments as follows:

- 1st installment equal to 50% of the total amount due, to be paid within 48 hours from the notification sent by the Student Office confirming admission to the single courses;
- 2nd installment (remaining 50%) to be paid by May 29th, 2026.

Except in the cases specified in this notice, fees paid for enrollment in single courses are non-refundable under any circumstances.

If enrolment has been completed remotely or outside University premises, the student may exercise the right of withdrawal within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of payment by clearly notifying UniCamillus of their intention to withdraw via registered letter with return receipt (raccomandata A.R.). Upon exercising the right of withdrawal, UniCamillus will refund the student the fees paid within the following 14 (fourteen) days, retaining a 5% amount of the paid fees for administrative services provided by the University, using the same payment methods originally used by the student, unless a different payment method is expressly indicated. Exercising the right of withdrawal is equivalent to submitting a formal request to withdraw from studies.

The University will only refund payments in the specific cases expressly provided for in this notice.

For all matters not covered by this notice, reference is made to the Statute and Regulations governing the functioning of the University.

For legal and interpretative purposes, the text of the Call approved by Rectoral Decree No. 82 dated February 13th, 2026, filed at the Office for Competitions, Decrees, and Regulations, drafted in Italian, shall be considered authoritative, and a certified copy can be obtained upon request.

6) Processing of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, UniCamillus University (located in Via di Sant'Alessandro n. 8, 00131 Rome), acting as Data Controller in this matter, declares that the required personal data provided by the interested parties will be processed exclusively for the fulfillment of the procedures described in this Notice.
