Notice of submission of calls for transfer requests to years following the first
MSc MEDICINE AND SURGERY (LM41) IN ITALIAN – Lido di Venezia Campus

THE RECTOR

- Given** Law no. 264 of August 2nd, 1999, "Rules on access to university courses"
- Given** Ministerial Decree no. 270 of October 22nd, 2004, "Amendments to the regulation concerning the didactic autonomy of universities;
- Given** the Statute of the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences;
- Given** the Teaching Regulations of the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences;
- Given** UniCamillus University's Code of Ethics and Organizational, Management and Control Model pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 231 of June 8th, 2001;
- Given** the "Tuition and Fees Regulation for EU Students of the Single-cycle Master's Degree Programs for the A.Y. 2026/2027 – Lido di Venezia Campus" approved by the Board of Directors on December 16th, 2025;
- Given** the several Decrees of the Minister of University and Research, which have defined, among other things, the places for degree programmes, with scheduled access, in Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics, and the Health Professions for previous academic years at this University.
- Given** the Judgment in Plenary Session of the Council of State no.1 of January 28th, 2015
"...according to which the student's request who – having been enrolled in an MSc programme in Medicine and Surgery at foreign universities – has requested a transfer, with recognition of both career and enrolment in years of the programme ensuing the first one, at Italian universities, should be considered worthy of acceptance; for the purpose of such transfer, the entrance examination required for the first year cannot be taken as a reference parameter. However, the University has the power/duty to evaluate the period of training carried out abroad and the number of places available for the transfer....."

- Considered** that access to nationally provided study programmes occurs within the limits of places available for Italian, EU and non-EU students legally residing in Italy, pursuant to Article 26 of Law no. 189 of July 30th, 2002, as well as within the limits of non-EU citizens residing abroad, pursuant to Article 46 of the Decree of the President of the Republic no. 394 of August 31st, 1999;
- Considered** that the maximum number of transfers to be accepted for each course of study with a nationwide scheduled number of students must be defined in relation to the number of vacant places due to renunciation or transfers to other universities;
- Considered** the availability of places made available for the MSc in Medicine and Surgery with national programming.
- Considered** the need to announce the filling of vacancies for MSc in Medicine and Surgery taught in Italian – Lido di Venezia Campus.

HEREBY DECREES

Article 1 – Available places

For the academic year 2026/2027, the available places for access by transfer from another Italian or non-Italian University to the MSc Medicine and Surgery taught in Italian – Lido di Venezia Campus with scheduled admission at the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (hereinafter referred to as UniCamillus) are indicated in the following table:

The number of available places may be increased by the same number of places made available due to withdrawal from study participation or transfers from UniCamillus University.

Article 2 - Admission Requirements

Only EU candidates and those treated as equivalent may participate in the selection procedure referred to in this call, provided that on the date of this call they are:

1. students who are enrolled in a single cycle master's degree programme in Medicine and Surgery who come from other Italian or foreign universities;
2. students who are enrolled in a single cycle master's degree programme in Dentistry who come from other Italian or foreign universities;
3. graduates in Dentistry who request recognition of their previous career for transfer to the MSc Medicine and Surgery programme in subsequent years after the first;
4. students enrolled in other master's degree programmes from other Italian and foreign universities who have earned at least 24 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus for transfer to the second year of Medicine and Surgery. For transfer to the third year, students must have earned at least 52 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus. For transfer to the fourth year, students must have earned at least 90 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus. Only courses and ECTS credits obtained by candidates corresponding to the first two, three or fourth years of the UniCamillus study plan will be evaluated depending on the case of transfer to the second, third or fourth year.
5. graduates in other master's degree programmes who have earned at least 24 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus for transfer to the second year of Medicine and Surgery. For transfer to the third year, students must have earned at least 52 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus. For transfer to the fourth year, students must have earned at least 90 ECTS credits in subjects that can be validated in the Medicine and Surgery programme at UniCamillus. Only courses and ECTS credits obtained by candidates corresponding to the first two, three or fourth years of the UniCamillus study plan will be evaluated depending on the case of transfer to the second, third or fourth year.

ECTS related to internships will not be taken into consideration.

Candidates referring to points 4) and 5) of this article and who have less than 24 ECTS credits will not be eligible for any transfer.

Under no circumstances are students who are currently enrolled in a degree course (three-year or single-cycle) at one of the Unicamillus campuses (Rome, Lido di Venezia, Cefalù) allowed to participate in this Call.

For students coming from non-Italian universities, UniCamillus will evaluate the educational path taken by students who request a transfer, with particular attention to the peculiarities of the master's degree programme, the exams taken, the theoretical studies carried out, the practical experiences acquired at the university of origin, and their compatibility with the teaching regulations of UniCamillus.

Calls for transfers of students enrolled or graduated under university regulations preceding the university reform set out in Ministerial Decree no.270 of 22nd October 2004 will not be accepted.

Article 3 - Methods and terms for submitting the application

The application for participation in this call must be made exclusively online (as indicated in Annex 1) through the GOMP student portal within the deadlines indicated in art. 4 of this Call. All candidates, after entering all the required information, must upload into the portal the following documentation:

- 1) application for participation in this call (*downloadable online from the portal*): the candidate may request transfer to the 2nd or 3rd or 4th year, indicating only one option in the application for participation. In case the application for participation is received without indicating the year for which the transfer is requested or if more than one option is indicated, the application will be considered null and void;
- 2) study plan;
- 3) payment of participation fees related to this call in the number of €170,00 (one hundred seventy/00);
- 4) syllabus of each exam taken for which recognition is requested, issued by the home University;
- 5) copy of a valid identity document;
- 6) enrollment certificate issued no more than 90 days prior to the submission of the transfer application, or, in the case of a graduate candidate, a degree certificate issued by the University of origin detailing the exams taken, marks obtained, number of ECTS credits, and subject codes. If the certificate cannot be submitted by the deadline, an appropriate self-certification may be provided only by students from Italian universities (*to be drafted on a format downloadable online from the portal*) containing all the required data. The self-certification has a provisional value and does not replace the certificate, which must be presented, even later, but within a maximum of 3 days after the deadline for the session for which participation is intended (see Art. 4). In case of non-submission of the certificate, the University will carry out the necessary checks to verify the truthfulness of the data declared in the self-certification.

If it is found that the access requirements required by this announcement are not met, the application for participation will not be considered, and the candidate will be excluded. In such case, the University will not refund the amount already paid and may refer to

competent authorities, given that the issuance of untrue declarations is punishable under the criminal code and special laws in force.

In the event that discrepancies are found following the checks, concerning the credits earned and the grades obtained in the previous career, the Committee reserves the right to proceed with a new assessment of the credit recognition to correct the previous one and potentially revise the ranking.

Students enrolled or graduated from non-Italian universities cannot provide a self-certification but must attach certifications issued by the University of origin attesting to the required information, accompanied by an authenticated translation into Italian, in compliance with the current legislation. Submission of the enrollment certificate must be made no more than 90 days prior to the submission of the transfer application. The study plan and syllabus of each exam taken must be produced on letterhead paper of the foreign University of origin, with the stamp and signature of the person responsible for issuing the document, in order to allow UniCamillus to interact directly, at its discretion, for any verification of truthfulness, together with the relevant official translation legalized in Italian and a declaration issued by the competent Academic Authority attesting to the grading system applied or the evaluation scale, accompanied by a faithful translation into Italian. Finally, students coming from foreign Universities are required to hand in a declaration issued by the Italian Embassy or Italian consulate certifying that their previous Institution is legally recognised as a University by the local government.

The described documentation must always be submitted through the GOMP student portal within the provided deadlines (see Art. 4).

Any other documentation will not be considered by the Evaluation Committee.

- 7) declaration of having read the information on the processing of personal data pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation no. 679 of April 27th, 2016 on the "Protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data" (hereinafter also "GDPR") provided by UniCamillus (*downloadable online from the online portal*).
- 8) self-certification, drawn up in accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445 of December 28th, 2000, attesting to the truthfulness and accuracy of the data and documentation submitted (*downloadable from the online portal*).

Note: the files uploaded to the platform must not exceed a total of 30 megabytes in size.

The University reserves the right to carry out checks on the documentation submitted by candidates, even after their enrollment following admission to the degree programme referred to in this Call. Should such checks reveal any irregularities resulting in failure to satisfy the requirements set forth in this call, enrollment in the master's degree programme will be considered null and void. In such a case, the University will not reimburse any fees paid, and may turn to competent authorities, as false declarations are punishable under the criminal code and relevant legislation.

The fee for participating in the transfer application process is €170,00 (one hundred and seventy/00 euros), and payment must be made exclusively through the methods permitted by the online procedure before the deadline specified for the session for which the candidate is applying (see art. 4).

Applications will not be considered complete until payment of the fee within the deadline specified for the session for which the candidate is applying. If the transfer application is submitted without the required payment within the specified deadline for the session for which the candidate is applying, the application will not be considered, and the candidate will need to submit a new application.

Incomplete applications, or applications sent in a manner different from that specified in this announcement or received after the final deadline indicated in art. 4) will not be evaluated and will be considered null and void.

The fee for participating in the transfer application process will not be refunded under any circumstances, even if the application is rejected due to failure to meet the required criteria.

Article 4 - Deadlines, Criteria and Evaluation of Applications

Transfer applications will be accepted based on the chronological order of submission recorded by the portal and will be evaluated within the following deadlines:

1st deadline: from the date of publication of this announcement until 8th April 2026;

2nd deadline: from 9th April 2026 to 24th June 2026;

3rd deadline: from 25th June 2026 to 9th September 2026;

For each deadline indicated above, if the number of valid applications received is equal to or less than the number of available places, no ranking list will be drawn up, subject to what is provided for students/graduates in courses other than Medicine and Dentistry in points 4) and 5) of Article 2 of this announcement. Therefore, all eligible candidates will be considered admitted to the transfer.

However, if the number of valid applications received is greater than the number of available positions, a ranking list that considers the chronological order of submission of the applications will be drawn up. If multiple applications are received at the same time, the Committee will consider transferrable ECTS credits, giving priority to the candidate who has obtained the highest

number of credits. In case of a tie in the number of ECTS credits, the younger candidate will prevail.

Only exams officially passed and officially recorded by the deadlines indicated in Article 4 will be considered in the evaluation of the credits recognition. Only exams related to courses that correspond to the UniCamillus study plan, as provided for in this announcement, will be taken into consideration.

ECTS credits related to internships will not be considered.

ECTS credits will not be recognized if obtained more than 8 solar years prior to this Call, unless the Evaluation Committee decides otherwise.

Calls for transfers from students enrolled or graduated under previous university systems, as outlined in Ministerial Decree no. 270 of October 22nd, 2004 will not be accepted.

In order to allow candidates who are admitted to the transfer to attend the scheduled lectures for the academic year 2026/2027, the deadline of this announcement is set to October 31st 2026, unless otherwise communicated. After this deadline, if there are eligible candidates left on the ranking lists who have not been admitted, they will lose the right to enrol, and if still interested, may participate in any new transfer calls subsequently published.

Article 5 – Ranking lists formation

The rankings will be published within 7 working days from the deadline outlined in article 4) and will be published on the institutional website (www.unicamillus.org).

Each ranking will include:

- a complete list of received applications, in chronological order
- candidate details in anonymous form (initials of surname, name, and date of birth)
- information regarding the outcome: admitted, eligible, not eligible.

Detail of outcomes:

Admitted: the candidate can proceed with the transfer according to the procedures outlined in articles 6) and 7) of this announcement;

Eligible: the candidate can proceed with the transfer only in the event of admission following the “sliding procedure” due to available places.

Not eligible: the candidate cannot proceed with the transfer.

Rankings will be published in chronological order in accordance with the deadlines indicated in article 4). Therefore, candidates who are eligible but not admitted to the rankings due to the exhaustion of places at the end of the Call in which they participated will have priority over eligible

candidates in subsequent rankings if places become available because of withdrawals or transfers. The rankings will remain valid until the final deadline of October 31st, 2026, unless otherwise communicated. After this date, no more “sliding” will be made, even if there are still eligible candidates in the rankings.

All updates regarding the availability of additional places and entry into force of the rankings will be made public on the institutional website.

The publication of rankings and all related notices on the university's website has an official value for the interested parties. Any personal communication that may be sent to the email addresses entered in the application form will only serve to facilitate the candidates in following the competition process but will not in any way replace the notices published on the university's website. It is therefore the candidates' responsibility to check their situation in the ranking by using the methods and within the terms provided to proceed with pre-enrollment or enrollment.

Candidates who withdraw or who do not complete the pre-enrollment and/or enrollment procedure within the times indicated in this Call will not be refunded the amounts already paid and will be automatically considered as forfeited.

Article 6 – Pre-enrollment and “sliding procedure”

The candidate who is admitted in the ranking list can proceed with the transfer by carrying out the pre-enrollment procedure within 5 working days from the publication of the ranking list, by 1:00 pm.

The procedure must be completed exclusively online through the GOMP student portal. The admitted candidates must:

- a) pay the first installment for administrative enrollment fees, amounting to € 6,000.00 (six thousand/00) as set out in the " Tuition and Fees Regulation for EU Students of the Single-cycle Master's Degree Programs for the A.Y. 2026/2027 – Lido di Venezia Campus". The payments must be made exclusively through the payment systems available on the GOMP student portal. Other payment systems are not allowed.
- b) submit a declaration attesting to having fully read the Student Contract and the Fees and Contributions Regulations for the academic year 2026/2027 (available on the University's website at the following link <https://unicamillus.org/en/services/annual-tuition-fees/>)

Any places made available due to withdrawals, outgoing transfers or non-enrolment of eligible candidates will be managed according to the following procedure:

- publication on the website <http://www.unicamillus.org> of a specific notice in chronological order of the publication of the ranking lists;

- the admitted candidates for “sliding” in the ranking list must make the payment of the administrative registration fees referred to in letter a) by 3:00 pm of the second day following the reopening of the ranking list.

If candidates are admitted following the “sliding procedure” in the ranking list after September 16th, 2026, they must proceed directly with the enrollment procedure as provided for in Article 7) of this announcement.

The “sliding procedure” will be repeated until all available places are filled and no later than October 31st, 2026, unless otherwise communicated. After this date, no more sliding will be made, even if there are still eligible candidates remaining in the ranking lists.

If pre-enrollment has been made remotely or outside the University, students may exercise the right of withdrawal within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of payment, by clearly communicating to UniCamillus the intention to withdraw, by registered mail with recorded delivery letter with notice of delivery. In case the right of withdrawal is exercised, UniCamillus will refund to the students the costs incurred for pre-enrollment within the following 14 (fourteen) days - retaining an amount equal to 5% of the amount paid for administrative and registration services - using the same means of payment used by the user for payment, unless there is an express indication of a different means of payment.

Those who exercise the right of withdrawal lose all rights in the ranking list.

Outside of what is expressly provided in this article, no refunds of the paid contribution will be made in any other case.

Candidates coming from another University who has proceeded with pre-enrollment at UniCamillus within the terms provided for in this article may continue to follow their previous study path until they proceed with enrollment. In the event that the candidate obtains additional ECTS credits following the completion of further exams (in addition to those already presented in the transfer application), they may submit an additional application for credits recognition within 30 days from the enrolment procedure (see Article 7).

Article 7 - Enrollment

From September 16th, 2026 until 1pm on September 25th, 2026, candidates who have completed pre-enrollment in accordance with Article 6) of this announcement may proceed with online enrollment, which involves the acquisition of the following documentation by the University:

- a) enrollment application submitted to the Rector and acceptance of the UniCamillus University Code of Ethics;
- b) student Contract;

- c) digital photography;
- d) valid identity document and tax code and, if foreign nationals legally residing in Italy, a valid residence permit;
- e) privacy information notice;
- f) *nihil obstat* transfer issued by the previous University, in Italian or in English, (excluding candidates who have already graduated). Until the students deliver a transfer clearance certificate, they cannot access classes and/or take exams. Delivery must be made by December 31st, 2026 at the latest. After this deadline, students will be deemed to have forfeited their place and will not be refunded any fees paid;
- g) Stamp duty of €16.00;
- h) Receipt of payment of the regional tax.

The payments indicated in letters g) and h) must be made exclusively through the payment systems available on the GOMP student portal. Other payment systems are not allowed.

Please note that, as outlined in the "Tuition and Fees Regulation for EU Students of the Single-cycle Master's Degree Programs for the A.Y. 2026/2027 – Lido di Venezia Campus", the subsequent installments of the annual university fee must be paid by the following deadlines:

- 2nd installment of €6,000.00 (six thousand euros) by November 30th, 2026;
- 3rd installment of €6,000.00 (six thousand euros) by February 28th, 2027.

Candidates who have completed pre-enrollment in accordance with Article 6 but do not proceed with enrollment will be excluded from the ranking and loses any right to the reimbursement of amounts already paid.

The enrollment procedure must be completed by following the instructions in the "Guide for Enrollment" which will be made available on the official website when the results are published. Any requests for assistance or reports of technical issues encountered during the enrollment procedure must be sent exclusively via email to office@unicamillus.org. Such requests will be addressed only if received within the deadlines specified in this article for completing the procedure. Requests received after these deadlines or sent to different institutional addresses of the University will not be considered.

Please note: To complete the enrollment procedure, it is necessary to have authentication and digital signature tools. The required tools are:

- Authentication and digital signature via **SPID** or **CIE** (strongly recommended and reserved for all students of legal age with an Italian identification document);

or, in alternative to SPID or CIE

- Authentication and digital signature via **OTP** (an alternative to SPID, particularly reserved for students of legal age who do not have an Italian identification document). The OTP authentication procedure can be easily performed, before the enrollment, directly on the GOMP student portal.

In the case of a minor student, the enrollment procedure must be completed by a parent or by a person exercising parental responsibility. In this case, it will be the care of the parent or the person exercising parental responsibility to have one of the above mentioned tools of authentication and digital signature.

Candidates admitted following the publication of the ranking or admitted following the “sliding procedure” after September 16th, 2026, must complete the enrollment procedure as described in this article within 5 days, by 1:00 pm, from the publication of their admission on the institutional website. In this case, they must pay the first installment of the university fees for a total amount of €6,000.00 (six thousand euros), as indicated in the " Tuition and Fees Regulation for EU Students of the Single-cycle Master's Degree Programs for the A.Y. 2026/2027 – Lido di Venezia Campus". The payments must be made exclusively through the payment systems available on the GOMP student portal. Other payment systems are not allowed.

With reference to the recognition of foreign qualifications, the University will follow the guidelines provided by the MUR “*Procedures for the entry, stay and registration of foreign/international students in higher education courses in Italy for the academic year 2026-2027*” and subsequent amendments (<http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri>).

In accordance with the provisions of the ministerial directive candidates who are admitted to the transfer and who hold a secondary school qualification obtained within a foreign education system must submit, by the start of the Academic Year, the documentation certifying the recognition of their qualification in Italy.

The accepted documents are:

- a) the Verification and/or Comparability Certificates issued by CIMEA, accompanied by a legalized translation of the qualification into Italian or English. To obtain these certificates, the student may access the following link: <https://www.unicamillus.org/it/accordo-cimea/> and complete the required procedure

or alternatively:

- b) Declaration of Value issued by the competent Italian Embassy or Italian General Consulate in the country where the qualification was obtained, including a legalized translation of the qualification into Italian or English.

Admission to the degree programme shall be considered conditional, until the student submits such documentation.

A student admitted on a conditional basis who fails to submit the above-mentioned documentation by the start of the Academic Year may attend teaching activities but may not sit examinations. The condition shall be lifted only after the Student Administration Office has received and verified the documentation. Furthermore, should the verification of the documentation relating to the qualification reveal that the minimum requirements for access to Italian universities, as set out in the above-mentioned ministerial notice, have not been met, the University may cancel the student's enrolment, retaining the tuition fees and university contributions already paid, which shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Enrollment is not considered complete without one or more of the documents required in this article.

If enrollment has been completed remotely or outside of the University, the students may exercise their right of reconsideration within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of payment. The student must communicate their intention to withdraw to UniCamillus University via registered mail with return receipt. In the event of exercising the right of withdrawal, UniCamillus will refund the enrollment fees within the next 14 (fourteen) days - withholding an amount equal to 5% of the amount paid for administrative and registration services - using the same payment methods used by the User for payment, unless a different payment method is specified. Refunds are not applicable to payments made for the stamp duty amount (€16.00) and the Regional Tax.

In any case, exercising the right of withdrawal is equivalent to submitting the request for withdrawal from studies as per Article 8 of this announcement.

Outside of what is expressly provided in this article, no refunds of the paid contribution will be made in any other case.

Article 8 - Withdrawal, Transfer, and Abandonment of Studies Procedures

Students who, after enrollment, wish to withdraw from their studies must submit a "study waiver application" using the online procedure by accessing the student portal (GOMP) with their credentials, then going to the section "career>applications>withdrawal from studies request."

The withdrawal from studies is completed with the release of the related leaving certificate. This form will only be issued to students who are in good standing with respect to payment of the required fees and contributions at the time of submission of the request.

In case of withdrawal or transfer, the amounts already paid up to the submission of the related request will not be refunded by the University under any circumstances.

The approval for outgoing transfer and the release of the related documentation can only be granted to students who are in good standing with the payment of academic contributions, fees, and stamps at the time of submission of the request.

Students who abandon their studies after the start of classes are still obliged to pay the full amount of fees and contributions required by the Tuition and Contribution Regulation for the academic year in which they are enrolled, which can be easily consulted on the University's website at the following link <https://unicamillus.org/en/services/annual-tuition-fees>.

No refunds will be issued for payments made except in the cases expressly governed by this notice.

Article 9 - Mandatory Vaccinations

Upon enrollment, students declare their commitment to provide, within 30 days from enrollment, documentation attesting to:

- the tuberculosis test performed according to the Mantoux technique, in accordance with the guidelines for the control of tuberculosis (provision 17.12.1998 of the State-Regions Conference) and by Presidential Decree No. 465 of 07.11.2001, which regulates the tuberculosis vaccination.
- vaccination against viral hepatitis B, pursuant to Law No. 165 of May 27th, 1991.

The declaration form can be downloaded directly from the University's institutional portal.

If the students do not produce the required health documentation within the specified deadline, they will be prevented from participating in academic activities, provided all other administrative obligations by the University Regulations are met.

If the above-mentioned documentation is not received by the deadline of December 31st, 2026, students will be considered withdrawn and will not be entitled to any refund of the payments made.

Furthermore, students declare their commitment to undergo any other available vaccination deemed appropriate by the University for the safety of the students and anyone they may meet during academic activities.

Article 10 – Processing of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, UniCamillus University (located in Via di Sant'Alessandro n. 8, 00131 Rome), acting as Data Controller in this matter, declares that the required personal data provided by the interested parties will be processed exclusively for the fulfillment of the procedures described in this Notice. The complete privacy policy is published on the following link <https://unicamillus.org/en/privacy-and-cookie-policy/>

Article 11 - Warnings

For any communication regarding the student's career, including administrative matters, the University will only interact with the student directly, if of age. Therefore, communications of any kind or purpose from third parties, including parents, will not be considered or responded in any way.

The University reserves the right to independently verify the truthfulness of the declarations made by the candidate at any stage of the enrolment process, by requesting confirmation from the relevant authorities, in accordance with current legislation. The candidates must therefore provide all necessary elements to allow for the appropriate verifications. If any false or misleading statements are found in the documentation submitted by the candidate, notwithstanding the sanctions provided for by the Criminal Code and special laws on the matter, and the claim for damage by interested parties against the declarant, any enrolment may be cancelled, any benefits granted may be recovered, and fees and university contributions paid may be retained.

The University reserves the right to change the location of internship both within the region and outside of it, and the delivery methods of courses, if deemed necessary for organizational reasons and/or health and safety requirements. Such changes will be communicated via notices posted on the University's official website, which is the only official communication channel of the University.
